Why attend this course?

This one-day course provides an introduction to the process of systematic review and meta-analysis. You will receive an overview of concepts and methodology, and guidance to support further learning. It is aimed at those early in their career with little or no research experience and there is no need to have previously performed a review. The course will be useful if you are planning or performing a systematic review, or to enable you to interpret published reviews.

Audience

Primarily early years' medical trainees (CMT2 and ST3) but suitable for anyone who wants to gain a basic understanding of this area.

What does the course cover?

- Introduction to systematic reviews
- Developing a research question
- Introduction to literature searching for systematic reviews including practical session
- What to do after the search, including assessing risk of bias and presenting findings
- Introduction to meta-analysis
- Clinical applications
