SUMMARY

ALS/ILS is no longer mandatory and therefore it is now not a requirement for Medical Foundation Administrators to confirm any ALS/ILS certificates before FY1/FY2 trainees can link to their curriculum.

PREVIOUSLY

FY1/FY2 trainees would upload their ALS/ILS certificates, but would require confirmation from the Administrator before they could link it to the curriculum:

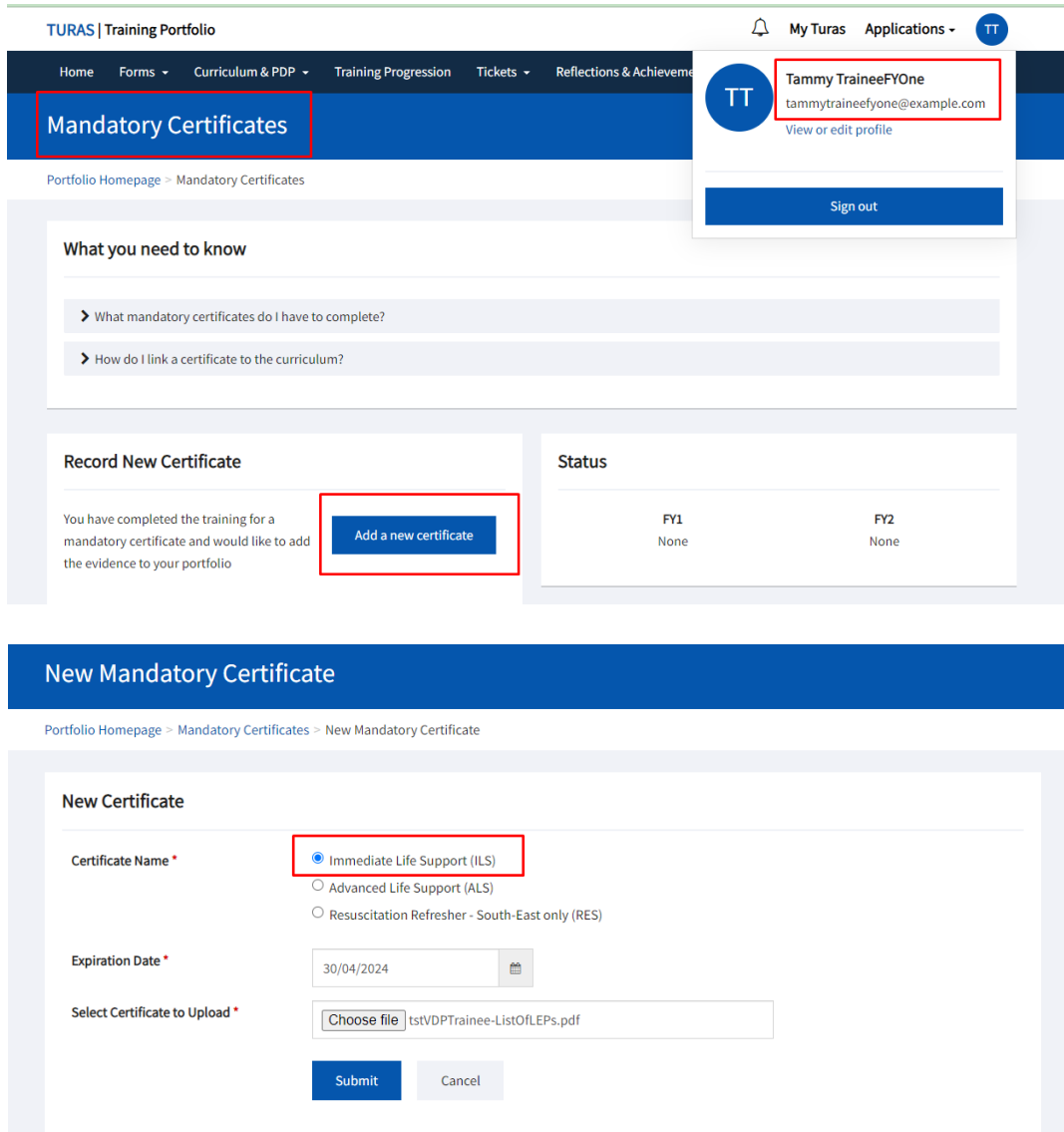

FY1/FY2 Trainee adds the ILS/ALS certificate through the usual process, via the Mandatory Certificates page:



Once added, the Confirmed status of the ALS/ILS certificate appears as “N/A”. The Trainee can link the certificate to their curriculum from the Actions dropdown menu:
